  - Identify and remove non-essential topics to balance learning objectives.
- The Board recommended initiating the revision process based on expert inputs.

The budget requirements for the Odd Semester of the Academic Year 2025–2026 were discussed. The allocation plans were reviewed and noted.

##### **2. Encouragement for Research Contributions:**









##### **3. Review of Reframed BEEE Syllabus:**



